Dear Mathematics Educator:

The 37th annual OCTM state mathematics tournament will be held Saturday, February 27, 2010. The tournament is sponsored by the Ohio Council of Teachers of Mathematics for the purpose of promoting student interest in mathematics, and to recognize outstanding students and high school math programs with monetary and achievement awards.

Tournament testing will be administered at 25 sites strategically located throughout Ohio. The test registration fee this year is \$4.00 per student. To avoid a \$25 late fee, registration fees must be postmarked by February 1, 2010.

High Schools may register up to 40 students, with the top 4 student scores making up the school team score. Students in grades 9 through 12 are eligible to participate in the tournament. Math students can register for the tournament as **independent students** and be eligible for individual student awards if their school is not sponsoring a team. So, if your school is not sponsoring a team, please share this information with your outstanding math students so they can visit the OCTM website regarding their participation in the 2010 tournament.
